SAFETY PRECAUTIONS









Personal protective equipment: always use personal protective equipment while handling the product.

Hand protection: Protective gloves (EN 374). The penetration time is determined by the protective glove manufacturer and must be observed. The glove material must be impermeable and resistant to the product / the substance / the preparation. Selection of the glove material on consideration of the penetration times, rates of diffusion and the degradation. The selection of the suitable gloves does not only depend on the material, but also on further marks of quality and varies from manufacturer to manufacturer. The product is a mixture of several substances, the resistance of glove materials cannot be predicted and must therefore be checked before use. Observe the manufacturer's instructions regarding the use, storage, maintenance and replacement of gloves. In case of damage or at the first signs of wear and tear, change the gloves immediately. The exact breakthrough time has to be found out by the manufacturer of the protective gloves and has to be observed.

Eye and face protection: Safety glasses with side protection (EN 166).

Skin protection: Cotton protective clothing and shoes that cover the entire foot (EN ISO 20345).

Respiratory protection: In case of high dust concentrations use a dust protection mask (EN 136) with filter P2 (EN 143).

Storage: Keep away from food, drink and animal feeding stuffs. Keep in a cool, dry and well ventilated place.

Personal hygiene measures: Use good personal hygiene practices – wash hands at breaks and when done working with material. Handle in accordance with good industrial hygiene and safety practice. EMERGENCY PROCEDURES

SYMPTOMS OF INTOXICATION/OVEREXPOSURE

Inhalation: Breathing dust can irritate the respiratory tract. Coughing, sneezing, nasal discharge, labored breathing.

Skin contact: Powder can cause localised skin irritation in folds of the skin or under tight clothing. Itching, redness, pain.

Eye contact: Dust irritates the eyes (by mechanical means). Redness, tearing, pain.

Ingestion: May cause abdominal discomfort. May cause nausea/vomiting and diarrhea.

DESCRIPTION OF FIRST AID MEASURES

Inhalation: Remove patient to fresh air - move out of dangerous area. If symptoms develop and persist, seek medical attention.

Skin contact: Take off all contaminated clothing. Wash affected skin areas thoroughly with plenty of water and soap. If symptoms develop and persist, seek medical attention.

Eye contact: Immediately flush eyes with running water, keeping eyelids apart. If irritation persists, seek professional medical attention.

Ingestion: Do not induce vomiting! Never give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. Rinse mouth thoroughly with water. In case of doubt or if feeling unwell seek medical help. Show the physician the safety data sheet or label.
